## 7<sup>th</sup> Annual JBT Regatta -- Notice of Race

### July 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020

**Invitation:** The Winnepesaukee Yacht Club is pleased to invite all sailors to the 7th annual JBT Regatta to benefit The Cure Starts Now Foundation.

**Eligibility:** The Regatta is open to any skipper or owner who wishes to participate. Participants must meet all Regatta requirements and submit a completed entry form with signed waiver by 5PM on Friday the 17<sup>th</sup> of July, 2020.

**Rules:** This Regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) *Including US SAILING Prescriptions*, this notice (except as to any modifications by the sailing Instructions), and the sailing instructions. All Skippers and their crew are asked to participate in the fundraising campaign to benefit the New Hampshire Chapter of [The Cure Starts Now Foundation](#). All participants must practice safe social behavior, including but not limited to, avoiding any congregations, especially at the Winnepesaukee Yacht Club (WYC).

**Scoring:** The low point scoring system (Appendix A2) will be used. The Two Turns Penalty, Rule 44.2 of the RRS, shall be replaced and a One Turn Penalty shall apply. For Class Awards, time adjustments shall be applicable for those who raise money for the Foundation. The Overall Regatta Winner is decided at the discretion of the Race Administrator and considers class size & competitiveness and the margin of victory.

**Entry:** Each entry must complete and return the attached form to Jesse Thompson by Friday July 17<sup>th</sup>. The standard entry fee \$40.00 is waived this year, however, all skippers are required to sign up on the website and raise at least \$100 for the CSN Foundation.

**Site:** Racing will take place on Lake Winnepesaukee. This event is a single day regatta. The Course will be an Island race for cruising classes and may, at the discretion of The race administrator, include multiple buoy races for racing classes.

The undersigned represents that all equipment aboard, including, but not limited to, safety and emergency equipment, is properly stowed, has been well maintained, is in good operating condition and is appropriate for this competition. The undersigned also represents that he/she and any crew permitted aboard the boat are experienced and competent, are physically fit, and capable of swimming or treading water in full sailing attire, and have been instructed in the use and location of all safety equipment aboard the boat.

The undersigned acknowledges that the decision to start and/or continue racing is the sole and exclusive responsibility of the undersigned.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, the undersigned certifies that each of the foregoing statements and representations are true and accurate and, on behalf of himself/herself and his/her heirs, successors and assigns, hereby releases and forever discharges The Winnepesaukee Yacht Club and the Lake Winnepesaukee Sailing Association and their respective members, volunteers, employees, agents, Officers, Board of Directors, Race Committees and Juries from any and all liability arising out of my participation in this regatta and all social events connected therewith, whether such loss is due to property damage, personal injuries or loss of life, even if such loss is due to the negligence of any party so released.
